The ornamental design for a key holder and connector for a wireless earpiece device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

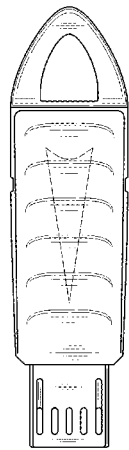
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a key holder and connector for a wireless earpiece device showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof, taken in the direction of arrow 3 in FIG. 7; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof, taken in the direction of arrow 3 in FIG. 7; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, taken in the direction of arrow 5 in FIG. 7, it being understood that a left side elevational view is a mirror image thereof; FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof, showing the device connecting a key holder and a wireless earpiece device; and, FIG. 7 is a view identical to FIG. 1 with descriptive legend directional arrows included which are necessary for better understanding of the drawing in accordance with 37 CFR 1084(o) and appropriate with good engineering practices, so as to best indicate in what directions previous views are taken so that nothing regarding the design sought to be patented is ambiguous or left to conjecture.

Any portion of any figure, including the printed indicia arrow head seen in FIGS. 1 and 7, shown in broken lines are for environmental purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

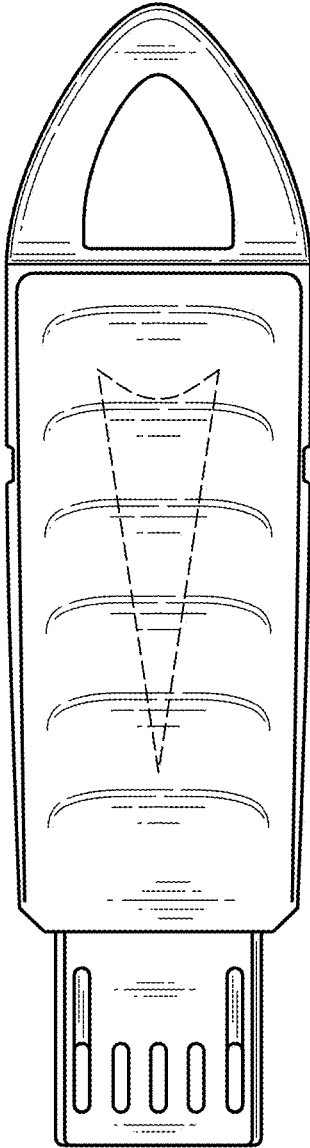

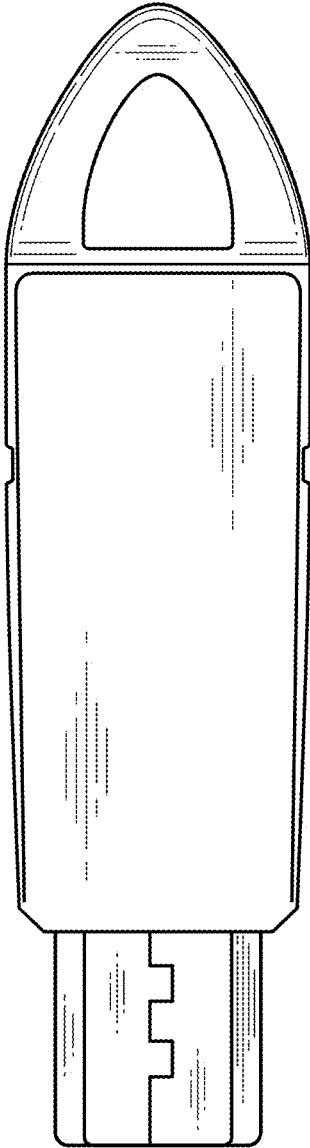

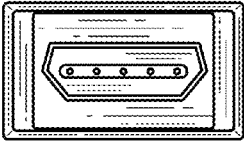

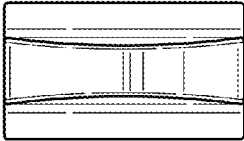

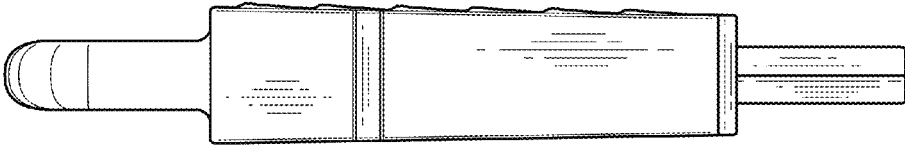

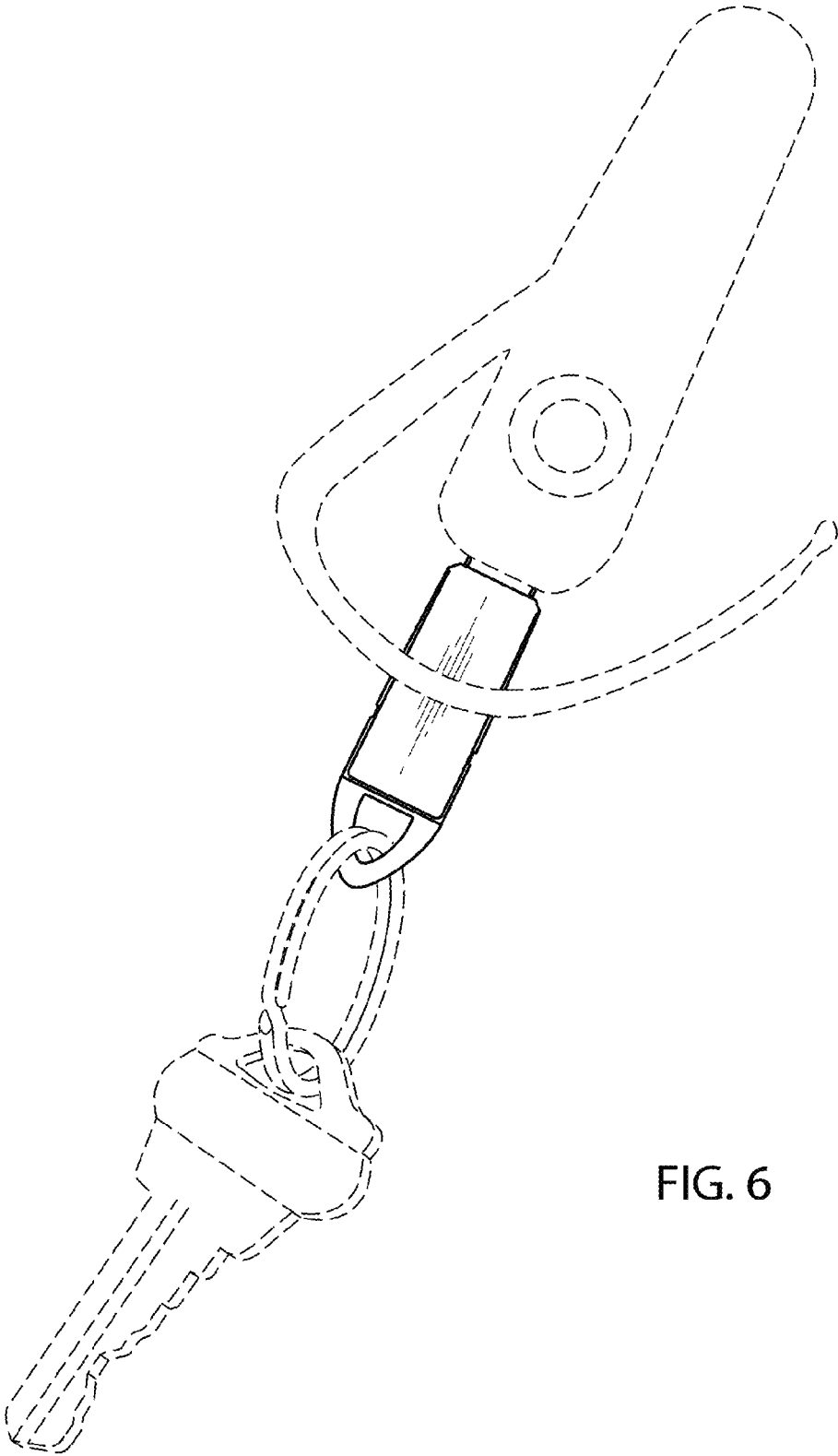

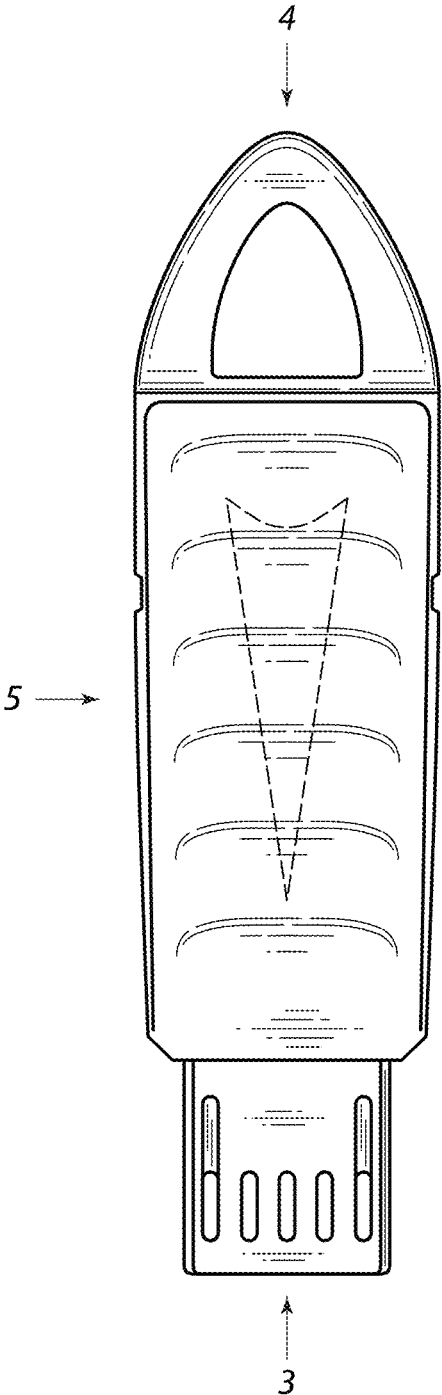
